

LMGA Rain Policy

LMGA will generally play if the course is open and conditions are reasonable. An email will be sent the morning of play if there is a threat of bad weather announcing whether or not LMGA will play that day. A message will also usually be included in the Landings Course Condition Announcement Line (912-598-3450).

LMGA will communicate throughout the day if weather conditions change. LMGA Leadership, with the advice of golf professionals, will make the sole decision as to whether a match will be scored or not. We may communicate through a combination of email, text message, the golf genius system or through golf professionals driving the course.

LMGA will suspend play when the lightning/hazardous weather alarm sounds. Players should seek a safe area and hold their position until a final determination is made whether or not play will resume.

Should LMGA suspend play during the round:

- 1) Any Holes-in-One will count!
- 2) Depending on the game being played that day,
 - a. LMGA may cancel the game entirely with no payouts and no charges
OR
 - b. LMGA may terminate the game through 14 holes for all groups, if the game makes sense to do so. The game results will be calculated through the 14 holes played, if applicable.
 - c. Once play had begun on BA Cup days our commitment to catering is locked in. Lunch will be served and all members signed up to play will be charged regardless of whether the actual game continued or not.
- 3) If less than 18 holes are played by all teams, no skins payout will happen. Players will need to come back to get their skins money returned, or else their skins money will roll over into the next skins game. Once skins money is rolled over, it goes into the pot whether that player plays the following week or not and is non-refundable.
